

# ESTONIAN STITCHES

## HOMework

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### **Estonian Lace Sampler/Scarf**

**Sizes:** Small sample (Scarf)

**Materials:**

Yarn: Fingering weight yarn, approx. 500 yards.

Needles: US 5 circular needles. (Gauge is not crucial in this pattern, aim for a fabric with good drape that will block well once we work lace.)

Notions: Waste yarn, crochet hook, cable needle, stitch markers.

**Techniques**

Crochet Provisional CO method:

Using waste yarn and a crochet hook, crochet a chain several stitches longer than required for cast on. Cut waste yarn and fasten off. Using working yarn and needles, pick up and knit cast on stitches along center spine of crochet sts.

**Homework Directions:**

CO 29 sts using Crochet Provisional CO. Leaving bottom sts on waste yarn, work 10 rows of garter as follows:

Row 1 (RS): Slip 1 st purlwise, knit across all sts.

Row 2 (WS): Slip 1 st purlwise wyif, knit across all sts.

Repeat these 2 rows four more times for 10 rows of garter, ending with WS row.

*Note: sts are slipped at edges to make picking up the stitches for the edge much easier.*

Leave sts on needle.
